Sooooooo...

- New Data Element: Section FTE
 - Applies ONLY to those courses for which your district is requesting supp wgt
- Calculating Section FTE:

$$u_1 = \frac{i}{\omega \rho_m} \frac{dp_1}{dx} \left(1 - \frac{\cosh[(1+i)y/\delta_v]}{\cosh[(1+i)y_o/\delta_v]} \right)$$

$$T_1 = \frac{1}{\rho_m c_p} (1-h_x) p_1 - \frac{1}{i\omega} \frac{dT_m}{dx} \frac{(1-h_x) - \sigma(1-h_v)}{(1-f_v)(1-\sigma)} u_1$$

$$dp_1 = -\frac{i\omega \rho_m dx / A}{1-f_v} U_1$$

$$dU_1 = -\frac{i\omega A dx}{\gamma p_m} [1+(\gamma-1)f_x] p_1 + \frac{(f_x - f_v)}{(1-f_v)(1-\sigma)} \frac{dT_m}{dx} U_1$$

Section FTE =

Total number of minutes course meets per year ÷
total number of instructional minutes per year

- carried out to nearest thousandth (0.000)

Community College Courses

Can be taken on various schedules →
different number of total course minutes →
same CCN can have different Section FTE

Same CCN taken from two different community colleges may have different Section FTEs

No need to fear – massive cheat sheet is here (or almost here) !!

Community College Courses

Seat time is tied to Carnegie Unit - Carnegie Unit is tied to SCED Code - SCED code is tied to course...

When do you assign a new course number?

1. Each distinct CCN
2. A CCN being taken thru more than 1 community college
3. A CCN taken on various schedules (e.g. high school schedule vs comm college schedule)

Community College Courses

REMINDER:

Section FTE \neq Carnegie Unit

Section FTE reflects minutes of course as a portion of total instructional minutes

Carnegie Unit reflects seat time as a portion of ~ 7200 minutes

Community College Courses

Other related items:

- Vendors have been asked to flag “fall” sections
- Courses eligible for supp wgt, NOT flagged in spring EASIER will be carried into funding for 2011-2012
- This flag eliminates need to use term ‘2’ for spring 2010-2011 PSEO courses
- Accountable District
- Importance of Course Method of Delivery → ICN

Community College Courses

NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SUPPLEMENTARY WEIGHTING:

- GED or high school completion courses
- Alternative school/at-risk program courses
- Courses for high school credit only
- Articulated agreement courses
- PSEO courses
- AP courses
- Courses for which student, parent or guardian pays tuition

Community College Courses

NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SUPPLEMENTARY WEIGHTING,
cont:

- Non-credit courses
- Developmental education courses
 - Includes ALL courses with CCN < 100
- Courses used to meet district's 'offer and teach' accreditation
 - Exception: PLTW

Community College Courses

NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SUPPLEMENTARY WEIGHTING,
cont:

- SDV, ESI, ESL courses
- Physical Education courses ????
- Independent Studies, Individualized Studies, Internships ???
