

# Summary of Results, 2008-2009 School Library Survey

The quantitative information that follows is based upon data from Iowa school libraries collected in **2008-2009**. Level 1 reflects the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile (half of schools are above and below that level), Level 2 is the 75<sup>th</sup> percentile and Level 3 is the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile. The 25<sup>th</sup> percentile is listed for informational purposes.

The 2008-2009 School Library Survey was aligned to match the "Guidelines for Iowa Library Programs." In comparing data from previous School Library Surveys, there will be some data points that are different.

References to the specific requirements and levels from "Guidelines for Iowa Library Programs" are included in **boldface type**. Items in parenthesis reference pertinent sections of the School Library Survey.
