

- Agenda Item:** Rules: 281 IAC Subrule 36.15(6)(b) - Summer Camps and Clinics and Coaching Contacts Out of Season (Notice)
- Iowa Goal:** All PK-12 students will achieve at a high level.
- State Board Role/ Authority:** Iowa Code section 256.7(5) gives the State Board of Education the statutory authority to adopt rules under chapter 17A.

- Recommendation:** It is recommended that the State Board give public notice of its intent to amend subrule 36.15(6)(b).
- Background:** 281 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) subrule 36.15(6)(b) sets out requirements for the operation of summer camps, clinics, and coaching contact for out of season sports activities.

This notice of intended action to amend 281 IAC subrule 36.15(6)(b) is intended to change the time period in which summertime coaching activities cannot be in conflict with sports in season from “summertime” to specific dates “between June 1st and the first day of fall sports practices.” This change is to ensure all schools are limiting these activities during the same specified time periods.

Notice of Intended Action

Pursuant to the authority of Iowa Code section 256.7(5), the State Board of Education hereby proposes to amend subrule 36.15(6)(b), “Summer camps and clinics and coaching contacts out of season,” Iowa Administrative Code.

This subrule sets out requirements for the operation of summer camps, clinics, and coaching contact for out of season sports activities. Specifically, this amendment would change the time period in which summertime coaching activities cannot be in conflict with sports in season from “summertime” to specific dates “between June 1st and the first day of fall sports practices.” This change is to ensure all schools are limiting these activities during the same specified time periods.

An agencywide waiver provision is provided in 281—Chapter 4.

A public hearing will be held on November 4, 2014, from 1:00 to 2:00 p.m. in the State Board Room, Second Floor, Grimes State Office Building, East 14th Street and Grand Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa, at which time persons may present their views either orally or in writing. After analysis and review of this rule making, no impact on jobs has been found.

The following amendment is proposed.

ITEM 1. Amend subrule **36.15(6)(b)** by adding the following:

281 --- 36.15(6)

b. A summer team or individual camp or clinic held at a member or associate member school facility shall not conflict with sports in season. ~~Summertime~~ Coaching activities between June 1st and the first day of fall sports practices shall not conflict with sports in season.
