

New Elements for 2012-2013

Preschool Program 1 Type

Identify type of preschool program the student is attending.

'3' SWVPP

'4' Non-SWVPP

'5' Early Childhood Special Education classroom only

Preschool Program 2 Type

For preschool students who are attending a second type of program within the district, identify the type of program.

'1' Kindergarten

'2' Transitional Kindergarten

'3' SWVPP

'4' Non-SWVPP

'5' Early Childhood Special Education classroom only

Note: For students only attending a Kindergarten or Transitional Kindergarten program, use a grade level of KG.

Preschool Program 1 Hours

For students whose Preschool Program 1 Type is '3' SWVPP, enter number of hours per week the preschool student is in SWVPP. Hours should be reported to the nearest tenth. (example: 10.0 or 12.5)

Note: If Preschool Program 1 Type is '4' Non-SWVPP or '5' Early Childhood Special Education classroom only, Preschool Program 1 Hours should be left blank.

Preschool Program 2 Hours

For students whose Preschool Program 2 Type is '3' SWVPP, enter number of hours per week the preschool student is in SWVPP. Hours should be reported to the nearest tenth. (example: 10.0 or 12.5)

Note: If Preschool Program 1 Type is '1' Kindergarten, '2' Transitional Kindergarten, '4' Non-SWVPP or '5' Early Childhood Special Education classroom only, Preschool Program 1 Hours should be left blank.

Preschool Program 1 Session

Enter Session ID from the Early Childhood Application for students whose Preschool Program 1 Type is either '3' SWVPP or '5' ECSE (Early Childhood Special Education only classroom)

Preschool Program 2 Session

Enter Session ID from the Early Childhood Application for students whose Preschool Program 2 Type is either '3' SWVPP or '5' ECSE (Early Childhood Special Education only classroom).

CPI Dual Enrollment

Added code '4' Testing Only, use for students who per Form A are CPI Dual Enrolled for testing only.

Destination Code

Deleted code '3' Community college program

Deleted code '5' AEA school or AEA sponsored program

Note: Students are no longer interim placed. Students in the above two programs should be kept active and a Service Provider/Facility number entered.

Changed code '11' to Incarcerated

Note: A student who is awaiting trial being provided education should be kept actively enrolled with a Service Provider/Facility of '90989600'.

ELL Placement Instrument

Added code '7' Tennessee English Language Placement Assessment (TELPA)

Entry Code

Added code '82' Nonpublic Shared Time for Nonpublic Schools

Note: This entry code only applies to a nonpublic school sharing students with another nonpublic school.

Exit Code

Deleted code '27' Interim Placed

Note: Students who were previously interim placed should be kept actively enrolled with the correct Service Provider/Facility number entered.

IEP

Deleted codes '1' PK Instructional IEP or K-12 any IEP and '2' PK Support Services Only IEP.

Added code '3' Instructional IEP, use for any student on an instructional IEP.

Added code '4' Support Services Only IEP, use for students only on an IEP for support services.

Note: All IEP students will need to be re-coded using the new codes.

PK Funded by Early Childhood Iowa (ECI)

This is only a name change, formerly named PK Funded by Empowerment.

Preschool Attendance

Deleted code '1' Yes.

Added code '2' Yes, attended a district sponsored preschool.

Note: District sponsored means your local district. For nonpublics, replace 'district' with 'nonpublic'.

Added code '3' Yes, attended a non-district sponsored preschool.

Removal Type

Deleted code 'L' Interim Setting by Special Education Administrative Law Judge
Changed code 'I' to Interim Setting

Reason for Removal

Added code 'Q' Special Education Administrative Law Judge Decision
Added code 'F' Threat of Destruction or Harm

Service/Facility Type

Added code '4' Transition Services – 4+ program, use for students being provided services by the community college or AEA to help seniors in the 4+ program meet IEP goals related to postsecondary work or education.

Added code '5' Dropout prevention Program on CC campus, use for students attending an at-risk/dropout prevention program provided by a community college.

Note: The physical location of the program may or may not be on the community college campus.

Deleted Elements for 2012-2013

Note: FAY is calculated using enrollment records sent in Student Reporting.

Charter School

Note: Students attending a charter school should be reported using the charter school building number.

Data Element Reminders for 2012-2013

Grade Level

Students enrolled only in a Transitional Kindergarten or Junior Kindergarten program should have a grade level of KG. Set the Kindergarten Literacy Assessment to '8' Transitional Kindergarten; Not Assessed.

Students attending a Day Services Program

If the day services program is not in your district, exit the student as Tuition Out District Paid to the school district in which the day service program is located. If your district has a day service program within its boundaries, enter non-resident students as tuition in district paid.

Reason for Removal

Bullying and Harassment should be identified as 'I' Other Violent Behavior with Injury or 'V' Other Violent Behavior without Injury.

Full-time Equivalency (FTE)

Enter the portion of time of expected attendance for a student and not the weighting factor.

Section FTE for Supplementary Weighting

Element must be populated to request supplemental weighting. For courses taught on-line or at the community college a spreadsheet listing contact minutes is available on the Student Reporting (EASIER) website. A spreadsheet listing contact minutes for community college courses delivered at various career academy sites is also available on the Student Reporting (EASIER) website.
