Summer Food Service Program

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) is starting up! Some feeding sites are open to all children. Click [here](#) for a list of open sites in Iowa. If an open site is available in your community, children from your center may be served meals *at the SFSP site*. However, the same meal may *not* be claimed for reimbursement on the CACFP. Center personnel should record the days, meals participation, and menus served through the SFSP *on separate documents* (not on the CACFP records) to show that children received meals.
