INSTRUCTIONS for using the Income Eligibility Guidelines (IEGs)

1. The Reduced Price IEGs must be used to determine Tier 1 eligibility commencing July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 for providers and parents who have submitted a complete Iowa Eligibility Application.
2. Total household income and household size from a completed Application must be compared to the reduced price guidelines above or entered in the ICIVES Excel worksheet to determine Tier 1 eligibility. Follow ICIVES instructions to use the correct worksheet. Attach the ICIVES calculation to the provider's Application. Sponsors will be notified when the new ICIVES document (effective July 1, 2016) is posted on IowaCNP "Download Forms".
3. Applications completed and submitted by providers applying for Tier 1 Income eligibility status (using income information) must include documentation of household income. Income documentation must be verified by the Home Sponsor. The definition of income is included in the CACFP memo (HP-2016-?).
