

## **Iowa Migrant Education Programs 2011-2012**

**Definition of Eligible Migrant Child:** a migrant child must have moved within the past three years across state or school district lines with, or to join, a migrant parent or guardian to enable the child, the child's guardian or member of the child's immediate family to obtain temporary or seasonal employment in an agricultural, fishing or food processing activity. The child must be age three through twenty-one (and without a high school diploma or equivalent) to qualify to receive services in a Migrant Education Program.

- Agribusinesses in Iowa include: meatpacking plants, grain companies, egg processing plants, poultry processing, crop work, and food processing plants.
- **Criteria for receiving funding:**
  - 5% of enrolled students in school district identified as eligible migrant,
  - Must complete weighted funding application to determine amount of funding.
- **Supplemental services provided can include:** preschool programs, before & after school programs, content area tutorials, ESL programming, health services, and instructional resources.
