Non-Fall Courses

Courses worth supplementary weighting that began after October 3, 2011.

- Typically identified as 2nd semester courses
- 2nd and 3rd trimester courses for districts utilizing a 3 x 5 block schedule
- 2nd, 3rd, and 4th block courses for districts utilizing a 4x4 block schedule

How do you know this is right?

- Courses listed were NOT included in Fall 2011 Certified Supplementary Weighting.
 - You may have had the same course in the fall, but the spring students are different (different set of students taking the same course offered in the fall). This is ok and the students are eligible for funding.
 - Check against your community college bills. The community colleges detail the courses, the students, and the term of enrollment.
- If errors are found, you must contact a Student Reporting consultant for the necessary change in your Spring 2012 EASIER data.

How do you know this is right?

- ICN courses during 2nd semester (2nd, 3rd, or 4th blocks) that were also NOT included in Fall 2011 Certified Supplementary Weighting.
 - If your district offered any 2nd semester courses over the ICN that were NOT included and not listed under the ICN link, call or email a Student Reporting consultant to have delivery method changed from face-to-face to ICN.
 - The delivery method drives the eligibility for supplementary weighting for courses taught over the ICN. Please check delivery method for your 12-13 ICN courses!!

PSEO courses are only eligible for Supplementary Weighting when the enrollees are nonpublic school students or Competent Private Instruction dual enrolled students. Spring PSEO courses taken by CPI dual enrolled and nonpublic school students are moved from Spring 2012 EASIER into Fall 2012 Certified Enrollment. Please verify the PSEO courses listed as complete and accurate for the CPI dual enrolled students and nonpublic school students. Any missed courses will need to be reported as audit adjustments if corrections are not completed now.

No changes can be made directly on the PEACE/Supplementary Weighting (non-Fall) application

- All changes must be completed in your district's Spring 2012 EASIER.
- Contact a Student Reporting consultant for assistance to change your Spring EASIER.
- If your student information system recorded the fall-start indicator correctly, then few changes should need to occur.
- Weighting factors are pre-determined following the community college's designation of a course as Arts & Sciences or Career & Technical.
