Spring 2016

Iowa Home Language Survey (HLS) Reminders

- Required to be on file for all newly enrolled students
 - 7/1/2015 or more recent
- Determines
 - Home Language Survey Date
 - Home Language Survey Identifier
 - Native Language
- If not returned,
 - HLS Date is Date it was handed out,
 - HLS Identifier will be 'Yes'

Home Language Survey Reminders, cont.

- If any language other than English is identified on the Iowa Home Language Survey
 - TELPA score is expected
- If the Native Language identified on the HLS is other than English
 - TELPA score is expected

ELL Status

- If no language other than English is identified on the HLS, AND there is no reason to expect the student needs English assistance,
 - ELL Status = '99' (Not Applicable)
- If the student scores proficient on the TELPA, ELL Status is
 - '5' (Tested and not identified as ELL)

ELL Status

- If the student does not score proficient on the TELPA and/or other identification methods determine language is a barrier, the ELL Status is either
 - '1' (In an ELL instructional program) or
 - '2' (Identified as ELL but parents waived ELL services)
 - REMINDER: parental waivers are required annually
- All students with ELL Status of '1' or '2' this spring will be expected to have participated in ELPA21

ELL Status

- Because ELPA21 cut scores will not be determined until Aug/Sept of 2016, per your district Lau Plan

NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO
BE EXITED OUT OF ELL THIS SPRING

BUT

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST BE EXITED
PRIOR TO 10/1/2016

- Reminder: TELPA results CANNOT be used as justification of EXITING a student out of ELL services

ELL Status

- Student can only be exited out of ELL services when they have met requirements of Lau Plan
 - ELPA 21 proficiency
 - Iowa Assessment proficiency
 - Same academic year*
- NOTE: since ELPA 21 cut scores will not be determined until Aug/Sept of 2016

NO STUDENT CAN BE EXITED OUT
OF ELL THIS SPRING
BUT
ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST BE EXITED
PRIOR TO 10/1/2016

ELL Monitoring

- Beginning Spring 2015 - Once students have been exited out of ELL services, they are required to have 2 years of monitoring
- Monitor Year 1 End Date = 1 year after ELL Exit Date
- Monitor Year 1 Decision is required for data submitted after that End Date has passed
- Monitor Year 1 Teacher is required when Year 1 Decision has been entered

ELL Monitoring

- If Monitor Year 1 Decision is to Continue to Year 2 Monitoring...
 - Monitor Year 2 End Date is 1 Year After Monitor Year 1 End Date
- If Monitor Year 1 Decision is to return to LIEP Instructional Program
 - Enter the 'Re-Enter LIEP' Date prior to 10/1
 - Change ELL Status back to '1'
 - ELL Exit Date needs to be deleted
 - Student will again need to meet minimum requirements to be exited from ELL

Spring Checklist

- All newly enrolled students in district (7/1/15 or more recent) ...
 - a. have a signed and dated HLS in cum folder
 - b. have a TELPA score if HLS Identifier is 'Yes' and/or Native Language is not English
- All students with ELL Status of '1' or '2' ...
 - a. Participated in ELPA21 testing
 - b. If status = 2, have a signed and dated parental waiver for 2015-16 school year

Spring Checklist

- No student has an ELL Exit Date more recent than 9/30/2015
- All students who exited ELL Spring 2015
 - a. Have a Monitor Year 1 End Date
 - b. Will have a Monitor Year 1 Decision if that date has passed
 - c. Has a Monitor Teacher Folder Number when decision is entered

What to Expect 2016-17

- New Element: Date Parents Waived ELL Services
 - Applies to Students with ELL Status '2'
 - Must be within current school year since waiver needs to be signed annually
- TELPA being replaced by ELPA21 Screener
- There is talk of ESSA requiring more than 2 years of monitoring, so watch for that in 2017-18
