

**Before We Get Started...**


- Housed in Portal -
  - Need A&A account to access
- Spring SRI needs to be certified before AYP can be certified
- Certification Dates
  - SRI June 20
  - AYP June 21

Due to tight timeline, Important to get test files in now thru your last day of school

June 21 is the certification date

Latest date to submit correct SRI file is June 18<sup>th</sup> due to overnight calculations of FAY and participation


**AYP APPLICATION: HOME PAGE, CONT.**

'Loaded from ITP' means that we have loaded your Iowa Assessment Scores

'IAA Loaded' means we have loaded your DLM results

As soon as your ITP test scores are loaded from **AND** you have a Submitted date for SRI, you can start digging in...

## AYP APPLICATION: TEST DATES

The first thing to check are the Test Dates

Source: ITP

The test date reflects the most commonly cited date on the Bar Code file

You can modify the 2015-16 test date by grade by clicking Edit on Far Left and entering the correct test date

NOTE: You cannot modify Test Date by student

If a Test Date is modified, you need to allow for the overnight process to update participation and FAY calculations

Last year's test dates cannot be modified

### **AYP APPLICATION: STUDENTS TESTED**

Source: ITP

Includes **all Students, all Entry Codes** (CPI students, tuitioned out students, etc) with Test Scores associated with your district

NOTE: Not all students reflected on this page are 'accountable' to your district

The first layer of Students Tested is laid out by a count - Building and Grade

**AYP APPLICATION: STUDENTS TESTED, CONT.**

List of students, Demographics, Test Type, Entry Code and FAY

- Data can be sorted by any of these column headings
- AYP relevant entry codes are noted on top of page on the application

Test Type: I = Iowa Assessment;  
 A = DLM;  
 Blank indicates no Assessment

FAY Building/District: Yes, No or 'No Match'

No Match may be your first hint of 'problems' – this means there is no match on that state id between the Assessment dataset(s) and SRI

### **AYP APPLICATION: FULL ACADEMIC YEAR (FAY)**

Full Academic Year means continuous enrollment at building and/or district from Test Period 2014-15 thru Test Period 2015-16.

*NOTE: For DLM students, FAY means continuous enrollment for the 2015-16 school year.*

### AYP APPLICATION: SUBGROUPS, CONT

Reading columns left to right...

1. Subgroups are defined based on Bar Code file and should reflect status at time of testing.
  - Enrollment Count (which includes Tested not Enrolled) is the denominator in the Participation Rate calculation
  - Enrolled not Tested reflects those students reported in SRI as enrolled for the entire test window but no test results are found. With few exceptions, these students need to have a Reason No State Assessment reported (see RNSA tab)
  - Tested Not Enrolled includes the students for which assessment results were found, the but student was not reported in SRI as being enrolled in that grade during the test period.
  - The column of students tested (which includes DLM) is the numerator in the Participation Rate calculation
  - FAY (for more information, see FAY tab)
  - Proficiency results will not be available until after the district has certified.

- 'Alternate Assessment' counts of students tested and FAY are DLM students

**AYP APPLICATION: REASON NO STATE ASSESSMENT (RNSA)**

All students enrolled during the test window of 2015-16, are expected to have assessment scores. If there are no assessment scores, districts need to report the reason for no assessment scores in SRI.

This portion of the application highlights those students missing both scores and reasons. Districts will not be able to certify until all students with no test type (blank), AND RNSA of '99' (cells highlighted in blue) have been resolved.

This page will also highlight 1) students that were tested below grade level; and 2) transfer-in students that were assessed at their prior district

Students tested below grade level will be included in the denominator of the grade level in which the student should have been assess, but not included in the numerator

Transfer-in students assessed in their previous district will not be included in your AYP calculations. Only one set of scores per student are used for AYP calculations – in these cases it is the first set of scores



**AYP APPLICATION: ITP V SRI**

This screen highlights any/all differences between elements on the BarCode file (ITP) and Spring SRI

ITP should reflect student’s characteristics at time of testing  
SRI should reflect student at end of school year

With that, it is possible that there are no corrections needed

However, if corrections need to be made...

- a. To the ITP column, contact an SRI consultant
- b. To the SRI column, make the needed change in your SIS, upload and approve a new file
